

MINUTES OF THE CAUCUS

APRIL 9, 2019

Interim Town Clerk, Lucille Dalton, called the Caucus to order at the Town Hall, 210 College Highway at 7:05 p.m. The required quorum of 25 registered voters was met. After the pledge of allegiance, the Clerk read the Warrant, Return of the Warrant, and a brief summary of taking out nomination papers versus the caucus process and how it relates to the Annual Town Election ballot.

Under the first order of business, the Town Clerk called for nominations for a chairman to serve the caucus. Karl Kuehner was nominated but declined. Gary Swanson was nominated and seconded to chair the caucus. The Clerk declared nominations closed, and Mr. Swanson was elected by unanimous vote.
